Amnesty for Lapsed CPFs

To use the CPF designation, your IAF membership must be in good standing. If your CPF designation has lapsed, you should have received a reminder notice from IAF to re-certify.

The IAF is offering a CPF amnesty program to those with a lapsed CPF:

- You can apply and complete your re-certification **before Oct. 31, 2016** at the current re-certification rate of \$350 USD, if you have maintained your IAF membership.
- If you have not maintained your IAF membership, your re-certification rate is \$450 USD + membership.
