

Date	Activity
<b>Early 2025</b>	Developing support programmes to promote the Power of Facilitation with a range of learning institutions in the Coastal Region
<b>August 2024</b>	Members facilitated a life skills training programme with young people at <a href="#">Glads House</a> , an organisation supporting young people who have been living on the streets in Mombasa
<b>June 2024</b>	Members participated in a clean-up activity in Mombasa Old Town marking <a href="#">World Ocean Day</a>
<b>April 2024</b>	Facilitated follow-up sessions with community facilitators with <a href="#">Support for Community Response (SCR)</a> in Mariakani, near Mombasa, on Group Facilitation Methods (Technology of Participation – ToP)
<b>April 2024</b>	Together with the IAF Kenya Chapter, we facilitated a one day Learning programme with <a href="#">Red Cross Volunteers</a> from Ukunda Branch in Kwale County, covering Group Dynamics, Intra-Personal Skills and Facilitation Skills
<b>May 2023</b>	We contributed more than 1,000 new and 2nd hand books to <a href="#">Akili Community Libraries</a> in Watamu, Kilifi County, and facilitated a one day Lifeskills programme with secondary school students being supported by the Libraries
<b>April 2023</b>	We facilitated a two-day Participatory Strategic Planning (PSP) process for <a href="#">Kisauni Vocational Training Centre (KVTC)</a> in Mombasa
<b>March 2023</b>	Our physical meeting was hosted by <a href="#">Big Ship Organisation</a> in Mikindani, Mombasa, where we visited their Mangrove project and later undertook training in the Consensus Workshop Method, an ICA’s ToP (Technology of Participation) method
<b>January 2023</b>	We held a two-day Strategic Meeting at <a href="#">Tudor Pastoral Centre</a> , where a team of 9 members developed a Strategic Plan to guide the Network for the next 3 years. This was also reviewed in August 2024
<b>November 2022</b>	We led a one-week training of facilitators on a Co-creation Method organised by <a href="#">ASAL Kenya</a> and ACCESS Kenya. The training brought together 16 facilitators from Somalia who support the implementation of a community-led Peace Security and Coexistence project
<b>October 2022</b>	We hosted a 3-day International Association of Facilitators (IAF) Eastern Africa Facilitators exchange with 18 facilitators from Uganda, Ethiopia, Tanzania and Kenya. The event was a mix of practical skills sharing and learning, and visits to local projects that make use of Facilitation in their work
